It's time for kindergarten!

There are twenty-four exciting hours every day in the life of a kindergartner, full of learning, playing, and growing. In *Kindergarten Day USA and China*, we join a kindergarten class in the USA from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM and learn how to count, read, tell time, and more. A clock at the bottom of each page tells you what time it is in the USA and China—a twelve hour difference, because they are half a world away. Flip the book over and follow a kindergarten class in China as they, too, learn to read, make friends, draw, and more.

Through photos and hand-made clocks, readers get a sneak peek into the busy lives of kindergartners and discover that young children have more similarities than differences. Young readers learn how to tell time and read a few Chinese words written in *pinyin*—a way of writing Chinese using English letters.

Trish Marx has written many nonfiction books, including *Everglades Forever: Restoring American's Great Wetland* (Lee & Low Books) and *Jeanette Rankin: First Lady of Congress* (Margaret K. McElderry). Trish lives in New York City.
